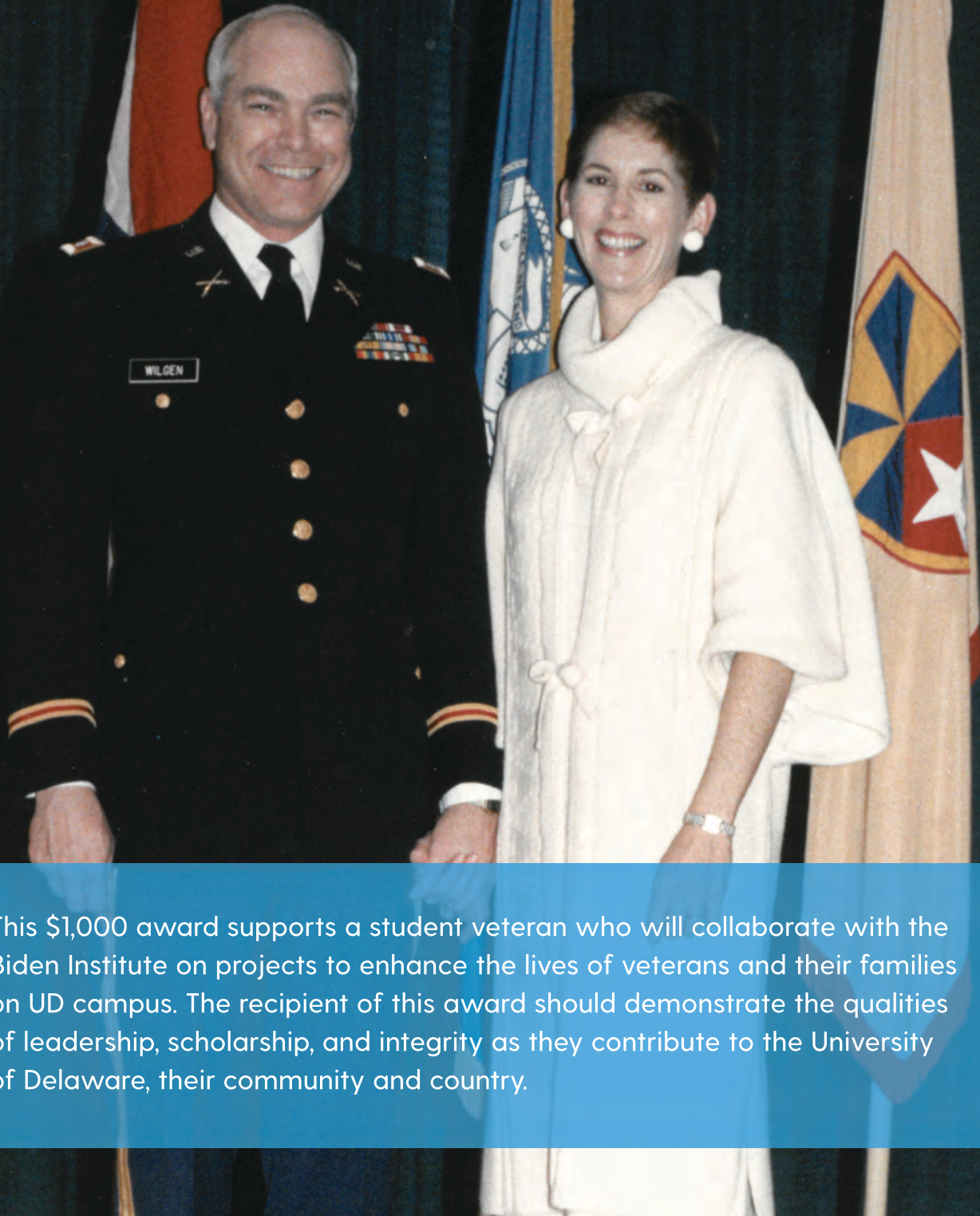

## AWARD CRITERIA:

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a US military veteran, graduate or undergraduate student in any major
- Has attended UD for at least 1 year
- Min. GPA of 3.4 evidenced by transcript
- Demonstrates appreciation for diversity and the betterment of society

Application packet must include:

- Student contact information form
- Resume incl. military service (1 page)
- 1 page statement on how you have demonstrated the qualities supported by this award
- Transcript
- Two completed reference forms
- A brief project proposal (250-500 words)
- that will benefit student veterans and their families on UD's campus.

## AWARD SELECTION:

Selections will be made by a committee appointed by the Biden Institute.

The recipient's academic department and college will be notified, and the recipient will be recognized.
