Application Sections

A: CANDIDATE

Candidate information, do not refer to your resume.

B: ACADEMIC BACKGROUND

List colleges and/or universities attended, degree(s) earned, and year received (or month and year expected), as well as grade point average (GPA) and base.

C: PROFESSIONAL OR VOLUNTEER EXPERIENCE

List relevant educational, volunteer, or professional experience.

D: CURRENT COURSES

List course titles.

E: COMPLETED COURSES

List course title, final grade, and semester completed.

F: RELEVANCE TO YOUR GOALS

Indicate why you want to participate in the Legislative Fellows Program. Include the relevance of the program to your educational and career goals.

G: SAMPLE MEMORANDUM

Take a few minutes to think about the multitude of problems facing state governments. Identify a significant problem of interest to you. Write a two-page memo to a legislator explaining the problem and recommend several possible solutions. Upload the memorandum to the application form as a file attachment.

H: REFERENCES

Must provide three.

I: RESUME

Upload to the form as a file attachment.

J: FERPA CONSENT TO RELEASE STUDENT INFORMATION

Read and agree to the consent form.
